

2014 MAISON L'ENVOYÉ BOURGOGNE BLANC

Review Summary



88 pts – Very Good "This very nice French Chardonnay from the Maconnaise area of Burgundy is a pretty yellow with a slight greenish tinge in the glass. On the nose, I picked up aromas of lemon, orange blossom, light oak and green hay. It is light to medium bodied and bit rustic with bright acidity. Its flavors are a slightly earthy green apple and lemon rind with integrated minerality. It has a very pleasant long finish with citrus, spice and hazelnut notes. A crisp skinned garlic roast chicken would be quite enjoyable with this wine."
